Do Not Track: Our Site is not designed to respond to "do not track" requests from browsers.

Verifying Your Request: Only you, or a person that you authorize to act on your behalf, may make a request related to your Personal Data. Verifying your request will require you to provide sufficient information for us to reasonably verify that you are the person about whom we collected Personal Data, or a person authorized to act on your behalf. ### **Cross-Border Transfers**

We may use encryption, password protection, secure socket layers, internal restrictions and other security measures to help prevent unauthorized access to the information we collect from and about you. However, any information you provide to us is at your own risk. We cannot guarantee that such information will not be lost, accessed without authorization, disclosed, altered, or destroyed.

#### **California Privacy Notice**

#### Last Updated: July 2025

This section of the Privacy Policy applies to those visitors or users of our online services and others who are residents of California, as required under the California Consumer Privacy Act, as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act ("CCPA"), and supplements the information provided above in our Website Privacy Policy.

As outlined in our Website Privacy Policy, depending on how you interact with us, we may collect or use information that identifies, relates to, describes, is capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with you or your household ("Personal Information").

Under the CCPA, you have certain rights with respect to your Personal Information, including the:

- a) Right to Notice. You have the right to be notified which categories of Personal Information are being collected and the purposes for which the Personal Information is being used, as outlined in our California Notice at Collection, our Website Privacy Policy and this California Privacy Notice.
- b) Right to Request Access to Specific Information and Data Portability Rights.   - Our business or commercial purpose for collecting and/or selling your Personal Information. The categories of third parties to whom we have sold or shared your Personal Information, if any, and the categories of Personal Information that we have shared with each third-party recipient.
- c) Right to Opt-Out of the Sale or Sharing of Personal Information. You have the right to opt-out of the sale of your Personal Information and/or the sharing of your Personal Information with third parties for the purposes of cross-context behavioral advertising, including email marketing, or profiling by submitting a request to us. You can also exercise your right to opt-out of the sale or sharing of Personal Information clicking the "Your Privacy Choices" link on the footer of the page or through an opt-out preference signal. If you choose to exercise this right through an opt-out preference signal and we detect such a signal, it will be honored. are necessary to provide our services and/or products or for other business purposes as identified in the CCPA.



Once we receive and confirm your verifiable request, we will delete (and direct our service providers to delete) the relevant Personal Information from our records, unless an exception under the law applies.
- f) Right to Correct. You have the right to request that we correct any inaccurate Personal Information we maintain about you, taking into account the nature of the Personal Information and the purposes for which we are processing such Personal Information. We will use commercially reasonable efforts to correct such inaccurate Personal Information.
- g) Right to No Discrimination. You will not receive any discriminatory treatment by us for the exercise of your privacy rights conferred by the CCPA.

Sale and Sharing of Personal Information

We do not sell your Personal Information for monetary consideration or as that term is traditionally defined. However, certain of our marketing or advertising activities or analytics tools used could be considered a "sale" or "sharing" of Personal Information under the CCPA. You have the right to opt-out of these types of disclosures of your Personal Information. An explanation of how to exercise your opt-out rights is provided below in **Exercising Your CCPA Privacy Rights**. We do not knowingly sell or share the Personal Information of California residents under 18 years old.

Shine the Light Law (Cal. Civ. Code § 1798.83): We only share Personal Information with third parties for direct marketing purposes if you either specifically opt-in, or are offered the opportunity to opt-out and elect not to opt-out of such sharing at the time you provide Personal Information.
